#### APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS: INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

#### 1) HIGH SCHOOL/IB DIPLOMA

- Completed in 2025 or before. You may apply with predicted grades.
- Grades should correspond to at least 17 out of 20 in the Swedish grading system (IB diploma score of 33). Admission is highly competitive and normally requires higher grades than the minimum requirement.
- Subject requirement: Mathematics
- Should correspond to at least Mathematics 3B/3C in the Swedish system.
- Subject requirement: English
- Should correspond to at least English 6 in the Swedish system. We also accept test scores from IELTS, TOEFL, Cambridge, and Pearson.

#### 2) UNIVERSITY ADMISSION TEST SCORE

Required from all applicants. Test score from SAT or ACT. No cut-off minimum score.

#### 3) CV/RESUME

Relevant education, experience, and extracurricular activities.

#### APPLICATION PERIOD

Apply from mid-October to mid-January for the fall intake. If you already have a complete diploma (gap year student) you may apply as an early bird in November and receive your offer in December.
